Upon the successful completion of your practicum, you will be eligible to sit for the Board of Certification Exam under the Canadian Institute of Public Health Inspectors (CIPHI).

Qualifications

- 3rd year or 4th year student or recent graduate in/from a degree program approved by Board of Certification of the Canadian Institute of Public Health Inspectors.
- Working knowledge of the Health Protection and Promotion Act and relevant Ontario Regulations is considered an asset.
- Demonstrated proficiency using Microsoft office programs including Word, Excel and Outlook.
- Strong time management and project management skills.
- Ability to work effectively independently or as part of a team.
- Strong interpersonal, organizational and problem-solving skills.
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills.
